



LAW ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT CAREER TRANSITION – SKILLS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

After completing the academic coursework and prior to beginning the Skills portion of the program, the following requirements and conditions must be met:

DRIVER LICENSE: Applicant must possess a valid driver license.

DRIVING RECORD GUIDELINES-APPLICANTS RECORD MUST BE FREE OF:

1. Driving Under the Influence any Implied Consent Revocation within the last 8 years immediately preceding expected date of graduation from the Law Enforcement program
2. Any one of the following Minnesota (or another states equivalent) within 5 years of expected date of graduation from program:
 - A. Conviction of careless or reckless driving,
 - B. Cancellation, Revocation or Suspension of driving privileges
 - C. Conviction of 4 or more moving violations
 - D. Conviction for leaving the scene of an accident
 - E. Two No Fault convictions under 169.792 or 56S.48

OR

One (1) such conviction within the year preceding expected date of graduation

PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION: The student will be given the MMPI-2 here at the college prior to skills admission. The results of the questionnaire will be interpreted by the college’s psychologist. Students falling outside of established standard deviation limits will be contacted regarding these variations and may result in a retake or face-to-face with the psychologist.

STAFF INTERVIEW: The applicant will be interviewed by a member of the program’s staff for the purpose of advising.

CRIMINAL HISTORY: The applicant will be provided a self-notification Criminal History Conviction Advisory form as well as a Department of Public Safety (or equivalent) Release of Information form allowing the retrieval of a criminal history from the students state of primary residency.

MEDICAL: The applicant must submit a physician’s statement on a form provided by the college certifying that the applicant’s medical condition is appropriate for engaging in demanding physical activity.

COLLEGE DEGREE (Reminder): The applicant must have provided an official copy of the college transcript identifying the awarded degree prior to admission into the academic portion of the transition program.

ACCEPTANCE: Acceptance into the skills portion will be granted only after a determination of compliance has been conducted regarding the above stated requirements and conditions.

I understand that the above stated requirements will be used in determining admittance into the skills portion of the Transition Program and agree to abide by these requirements.
